(a),(b) & (c) Yes, Sir. A New Integrated Terminal Building (NITB) with modern passenger facilities like Passenger Boarding Bridges, Conveyors, Escalators and Elevators is under construction at Madurai Airport at an estimated cost of Rs. 128.76 crores. NITB can handle 500 passengers at a time. The entire project is expected to be completed by December, 2009.
