Will the Minister of COALCOALEXTERNAL AFFAIRSEXTERNAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether it is a fact that incidents of incursion into the Indian territory by the Chinese security forces have increased in the recent past;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the special steps taken by Government to stop re-occurrence of such incidents?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) There has been no increase in the incidents of incursions in the recent past. Since 1993, the two Governments have agreed to maintain peace and tranquility along the Line of Actual Control in the India-China border areas, without prejudice to their respective positions on the alignment of the line of actual control as well as on the boundary question. Government regularly takes up any violation along the LAC with the Chinese side through established mechanisms including the Joint Working Group, the Expert Group, border personnel meetings, flag meetings and diplomatic channels.
