STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 233 FOR 04.12.2009 ASKED BY SHRI MANOHAR JOSHI, MP REGARDING BHARGAVA COMMITTEE ON IIMs.

- (a) to (c): The Government has consulted the Board of Governors of individual IIMs on the recommendation of the R.C. Bhargava Committee on the creation of a Pan – IIM Board. Since none of the IIMs were agreeable to the concept, the Ministry in consultation with IIMs has proposed that an informal body comprising Directors of IIM headed by the HRM will meet every six months, to deal with issues common to all IIMs.
