STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (c) OF UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 1032 BY DR. RAM PRAKASH TO BE ANSWERED IN RAJYA SABHA ON 27.11.2009 REGARDRING RAIL LINE WORKS IN HARYANA.

- (a) to (c): No new line work in Haryana was completed in the last three years. There are two ongoing new line projects as under:-
- i) Rewari-Rohtak new line (75 km.) is in progress with anticipated cost of Rs. 475.17 crore. Rewari-Jhajjar portion is targeted for completion during 2009-10 and Jhajjar-Rohtak during 2010-11. 4 Road Over Bridges, 30 Road Under Bridges, 37 Manned Level Crossings are proposed on this rail line project. No Unmanned Level Crossing is proposed.
- ii) Jind-Sonepat new line (81 km.) is in progress with anticipated cost of Rs. 385.95 crore. Land acquisition, bridgework, blanketing works are in progress. 2 Road Over Bridge, 34 Road Under Bridges and 40 Manned Level Crossings are proposed on this rail line. No Unmanned Level Crossing is proposed. No target date has yet been fixed. The works are being progressed as per the availability of resources.
