(a) & (b):Di-Ammonium Phosphate (DAP) is decontrolled/ de-canalized since 1992.

The availability of DAP fertilizers is decided by the market forces of demand and supply.

Union Government monitors availability of fertilizers at State level and State

Governments are responsible for its tie-up with the manufacturers & importers and

further distribution within the State. The State-wise requirement, availability and sales of

DAP during the year 2009-10 (April'09 to November'09) is Annexed.
