(a) & (b) : The government plans to use the sports infrastructure for sports and allied purposes after the Commonwealth Games. Government is also cautious to the need of proper post legacy use of the sports infrastructure being renovated/constructed for the Commonwealth Games.

For this purpose plans to optimally use the stadia owned by Government, have been formulated to increase the economy, efficiency and effectiveness through partnership with private providers. It is also proposed to enter into a 'Memorandum of Understanding' with the owners of other stadia which are being funded by Government.
