(a) to (d) We have seen reports that Pakistan has denied that it had agreed to accept the bodies of four of the nine terrorists killed in the Mumbai terror attack. The Government of Pakistan has not approached the Government of India in this regard. However, Pakistan has confirmed the identity of some of the terrorists killed in the Mumbai attack, based on the DNA reports provided by the Government of India to Pakistan.
