- (a) whether the Government has prepared any security plan for the delegates of 2010 Commonwealth Games;
- (b) If so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has held discussion with the delegates of participating countries who have in the recent past visited India;
- (d) If so, the details of various issues raised by these delegates;
- (e) the details of the areas related to security yet to be prepared/made available for the success of the games in India; and
- (f) the target fixed for completion of such aspects?

ANSWER

(a)& (b): The Government has prepared a comprehensive security plan for all the delegates for the Commonwealth Games 2010 in consultation with the Central Security Agencies and Delhi Police. An International Security Liaison Group has been constituted by Ministry of Home Affairs with representatives from different security agencies, Ministry of Defence, Ministry of External Affairs and others to effectively liaison with all the delegates for the Commonwealth Games and to address the security concerns of these delegates.

(c) & (d): A briefing of all Heads of Missions was organized in New Delhi on 9th September, 2009. Besides, an International Conference of the Security Administrators of all participating Countries was also organized on 23rd & 24th September, 2009 successfully at New Delhi.

(e)&(f): The security arrangements for the delegates is an ongoing process which is being continuously updated/fine tuned in consultation with all the concerned security agencies.
