Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN POVERTY ALLEVIATION be pleased to state :-

- (a) the number of housing units allotted to urban poor in Uttar Pradesh during last three years, year-wise and city-wise;
- (b) the number of housing units proposed to be constructed during the year 2008-09 and 2009-10, year-wise and city-wise and the number of eligible families to whom these units would be allotted; and
- (c) the break-up of expenditure incurred by Union / State Government on these schemes during last three years?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) A total of 67 projects under Basic Services to the Urban Poor (BSUP) and 133 projects under Integrated Housing & Slum Development Programme (IHSDP) have been approved for construction/ upgradation of 67,992 and 31,969 houses respectively during the years 2006-07 to 2008-09 for the State of Uttar Pradesh. The year-wise and town-wise details of these projects, including details of Central share are given in Annexure. No project under BSUP or IHSDP has been approved in the State of Uttar Pradesh during 2009-10. However, Rs. 23.78 crore of enhanced Additional Central Assistance (ACA) has been approved during 2009-10 for 77 IHSDP projects in Uttar Pradesh.
