- (e) whether Government has considered assessment of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan; and
- (f) if so, the steps taken by Government over this assessment?

- (a): A statement showing Central Budget support released to States/ UTs for implementation of Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) programme from 2005-06 onwards is at Annexure.
- (b) to (d): Annual Works Plan & Budget proposals of all the 35 States/UTs are approved on annual basis in the beginning of financial year for implementation of SSA programme.
- (e) & (f): The implementation of SSA programme is reviewed on six monthly basis by a Joint Review Mission (JRM) comprising educational experts & representatives from International Development Financial Institutions. So far ten such reviews have taken place. The 10th JRM held from 20th to 31st July, 2009 has noted the progress towards the SSA goals with considerable satisfaction.
