(a) & (b) The Government of Andhra Pradesh has requested to upgrade the following five State roads for upgradation to National Highways:

i. Hyderabad-Srisailam-Dornala-Atmakur-Nandyal ii. Guntur-Vinukonda-Thakapalli-Nandyal-Banaganapalli-Thadapatri-Dharmavaram-Kodur (connecting NH 5 to NH 7) iii. Adilabad-Utnoor-Khanapur-Korutla-Vemulawada-Siddipet-Janagon-Suryapeta-Miryalguda-Piduguralla-Narasaraopeta-Vodarevu iv. Sironcha-Mahadevapur-Parkal-Warangal-Tungaturthi-Nakrekal-Nalgonda-Chalakurthi-Macherla-Erragondapalem-Thokapalli-Markapur-Besthavaripeta– Kanigiri-Rapur-Venkatagiri-Renigunta v. Kakinada-Dwarapuydi-Rajamundry-Kovvur-Jangareddygudem-Aswaaraopeta- Khammam-Suryapeta

(c) Expansion of National Highway network is a continuous process and declaration of new National Highway is taken up from time to time depending upon, requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and availability of funds.
