Will the Minister of COAL HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE INFORMATION AND BROADCASTING CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether Terminal-3 of Indira Gandhi International Airport has been equipped to handle large commercial carriers like Air Bus A-380;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, by when it will be ready to handle large number of passengers in view of Commonwealth Games this year?

(a) & (b) Yes, Sir. Three international contact stands of terminal 3 have been equipped with Triple Arm Passenger Boarding Bridges (PBBs), two serving the main deck and the third serving the upper deck of Airbus-380 aircraft. The arrival baggage carousels serving Airbus-380 flights have longer claim length. All gate lounges supporting Airbus-380 operations have been sized as per norms applicable with adequate seating capacity. Aircraft Stands and taxing lanes have been dimensioned for Airbus-380 (code F aircraft) with adequate clearances.
