- (a)whether it is a fact that India has the capacity to produce 2.500 MW of power from waste as per the study conducted by ASSOCHAM;
- (b) what are the other findings of the study; and
- (c)what efforts the Ministry is making in setting up of waste energy projects to generate power in the country?

- (a)&(b):ASSOCHAM have informed that they have not carried out any study on potential of Energy Recovery from Wastes. Based on the internal discussions of the Chambers, ASSOCHAM has indicated a potential of 2500 MW power from waste in a press statement issued on April 23, 2010.
- (c):Ministry of New and Renewable Energy is implementing Programmes on energy recovery from urban and industrial wastes. The programmes provide for financial assistance for setting up of projects, research & development and dissemination of information. Business meets and workshops on energy recovery from wastes are being organized for raising awareness about waste-to-energy activities in high potential industry sector such as distilleries, pulp & paper and starch & sago.
