(b) to (e): Development, promotion and monitoring of tourism is primarily undertaken by the State Governments/Union Territory Administrations. However, the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India provides Central Financial Assistance to the project proposals identified in consultation with them under various schemes of the Ministry. The project proposals submitted by the State Governments/UT Administrations are appraised as per respective scheme guidelines and those projects which are complete in all respects are sanctioned subject to inter-se priority and availability of funds. Ministry of Tourism has sanctioned 21 projects for 88.90 crore during the 11th Plan period upto 30th September, 2010. State Level Monitoring Committee reviews the progress of projects.

(f): Rajasthan was ranked 6th in India in the year 2009, as far as Foreign Tourist Visits is concerned.
