- (a) whether it is a fact that many heavy industries Public Sector Units (PSUs) in the country are either closed or are on the verge of closure;
- (b) if so, the details of such industries, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government has formulated any scheme to revive and make sick industries productive located in North-East Region (NER);
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefore?

(a) & (b): Based on the Public Enterprises Survey (various issues), 5 CPSEs have been closed during the period 2005-06 to 2008-09. The state-wise details of these 5 closed CPSEs is given below. Out of these 5 closed CPSEs, moreover, only BYNL comes under the category of Heavy (engineering) Industries.
