**PERFORMANCE STUDY ON JNNURM**

(a) whether Government has made a data collection and performance study on the implementation of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) in every State;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) the accountability clauses enforced, if the deficiency is found?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c): The Government has undertaken Mid term appraisal of the Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JNNURM) to assess whether the overall objective of the Mission are being fulfilled, identify critical constraints in implementation of the Mission and suggest remedial measures. The appraisal is to cover a minimum of one city of each State and cover all sectors under JNNURM. The appraisal is not yet complete. However, each State Level Nodal Authority is required to submit a Quarterly Progress Report (QPR) indicating the financial and physical progress of projects and the status of implementation of reforms. Analysis of QPRs is reviewed at the meeting of Central Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (CSMC). The CSMC also reviews the performance of State/Cities at the time of sanctioning of fresh projects and second and subsequent installments and makes decision on further release of funds.
