- (a) & (b) Shale is a form of sediment which exists in various basins of India. Government has initiated the process of identification of prospective areas and assessment of shale gas resources in the country.
- (c) Extraction technology for the shale gas involves drilling of horizontal wells along with well stimulation technique such as hydro-fracturing etc. These technologies are available in the country.
