- (a) whether it is a fact that all the thirty two Air India employees who were suspended in May this year would be reinstated;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that a large number of contracted workers in Alliance Air would be absorbed in the organization; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) and (b): Air India is taking action against the suspended employees as per the Rules. Revocation of suspension is being decided on a case to case basis.
