Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state :-

- (a) the number of incidents of bird hit that occurred at Jaipur airport during the last one year;
- (b) whether the main reason for large number of birds hovering around the airport is the absence of a high boundary wall around the airport due to which people living nearby throw carcasses of animals there; and
- (c) whether any concrete action has been taken by Government to check this practice?

(a):- The number of bird hits reported at Jaipur airport from October, 2009 till date is 19.

(b) and (c):- No, Sir. The boundary walls around the airport are as per specified standards. No carcasses of animals are being thrown inside the airport.
