Will the Minister of COALENVIROMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether there is any proposal under consideration of the Ministry to establish coastal zone project during the current Eleventh Five year Plan period, State-wise;
- (b) if so, the details thereof including the locations identified for the purpose including Gujarat; and
- (c) by when such proposal is likely to be implemented/sanctioned?

(SHRI JAIRAM RAMESH):

(a) & (b) The Ministry of Environment and Forests has initiated an Integrated Coastal Zone Management Project (ICZMP) with the assistance of World Bank. The project was launched in September, 2010 and the project period is for 5 years. The States involved in the project include Orissa, West Bengal and Gujarat. In Gujarat, the project is implemented at Gulf of Kachchh and at Dandi Village.

(c) The project is already under implementation.
