UNIFORMITY IN TENURE OF HEADS OF REGULATORY BODIES

Will the Minister of COALLAW & JUSTICE be pleased to state :-

- (a) Whether Government has decided to bring uniformity in tenure of head of various regulatory bodies and has asked the Ministry to work on comprehensive amendments to the respective laws;
- (b)if so, whether currently some regulatory heads have a three year tenure, while others have five years;
- (c)if so, whether Government is of the view that the uniformity could be effected early for the appointment of new chiefs of SEBI and RBI and both would have a rive years term; and
- (d)if so, by when a final decision in this regard is likely to be taken.

- (a)Yes Sir;
- (b)As per Department of Personnel & Training O.M No. 3/6/97-Estt.(Pay.II) dated 29th January, 1998 the term of appointment of the Chairperson would be a uniform period of five years or till the age of 65 years whichever is earlier.
- (c & d) A proposal is under consideration.
