- (e) whether tax incentives have cost Government `68,914 crore revenue in 2008-09;

- (a) & (b) Out of about 4,10,000 companies who filed the return of income in the Financial Year 2008-09, the number of companies who paid taxes was about 2,35,000.
- (c) & (d) The reasons for not paying taxes by about 1,75,000 companies could be either reported losses of the year or set-off of the losses/ unabsorbed depreciation allowance brought forward from preceding year(s) or admissible exemptions / deductions under various provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961; etc.
- (e) Yes Sir.
- (F) & (g) The provisions regarding profit-linked deductions / exemptions (which account for the maximum revenue forgone) are being replaced by investment-linked deductions/exemptions for specified sectors.
