- (a) whether Government proposes to get an Assessment and Evaluation Centre set up by CBSE in order to meet the requirements pertaining to the valuation of school syllabi, educational quality and standard of education;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether such centres will be set up by Government in all the States of the country; and
- (d) the time by when such centres would be set up by Government?

ANSWER

- (a) and (b): The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) proposes to establish a Centre for Assessment, Evaluation and Research on private public partnership (PPP) mode. The objectives of the Centre are:
- (i) to create research capability and assessment resources of international quality,
- (ii) to establish a system through diagnostic testing to provide input to CBSE regarding student learning as well as providing professional development and leadership training, and
- (iii) to conduct research into policies and programs that can improve student learning and teaching quality.
- (c) and (d): There is no such proposal at present.
