(a) Request for introduction of overnight express train service between Bangalore and Secunderabad have been received from Andhra Pradesh Government. 2493/2494 Bangalore-Nizamuddin Rajdhani Express (Tri-Weekly) has been introduced with effect from 26.03.2010 which is providing an overnight service between Secunderabad and Bangalore alongwith 2429/2430 Bangalore - Nizamuddin Rajdhani Express running four days a week. Presently, Secunderabad and Bangalore are connected by 11 pairs of trains including 3 pairs of originating/terminating trains.
