- (a) whether the details of all the medical colleges and hospitals of the country are available with the Central Government;
- (b) if so, the number of medical colleges and hospitals in Orissa at present and their names;
- (c) whether there is any proposal pending for opening a Government medical college or hospital in the State; and
- (d) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI DINESH TRIVEDI)

- (a) Yes.
- (b) There are 6 medical colleges & hospitals existing in the State of Orissa. The details are as under:
- (i) SCB Medical College & hospital, Cuttack;
- (ii) MKCG Medical College & Hospital, Berhampur
- (iii) VSS Medical College & Hospital, Burla
- (iv)Hi-Tech Medical College & Hospital, Bhubaneshwar
- (v) Kalinga Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhubaneswar
- (vi) Institute of Medical Sciences and SUM Hospital, Bhubaneswar.
- (c) No.
- (d) As per the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and Regulations made thereunder, it is for concerned State Government to apply to the Central Government for opening a medical college in the country.
