The Government of India has permitted foreign airlines also to invest, in the capital of Indian companies, operating scheduled and non-scheduled air transport services, up to the limit of 49% of their paid up capital vide the Press Note Number 6/2012 dated 20.9.2012 issued by the Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion, Ministry of Commerce & Industry. However, the revised policy is not applicable to Air India.
