PRIVATISATION OF KOLKATA AIRPORT

- (a) & (b): No, Sir. However, Government of India (GoI) intends to undertake the Operation, Management and Development of Kolkata airport under Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode. Airports Authority of India (AAI) has issued Request for Qualification (RFQ) document on 30.12.2014. RFQ dates have been extended in past on account of 'in principle' approval of the competent authority in the Government.
- (c): Presently, no such milestones have been set to finalize the transaction documents for award of the project.
