# ONLINE AIRPORT ENTRY PASSES

(a): Yes, Sir.

(b): The project relating to e-BCAS (Bureau of Civil Aviation Security) provides for online access to users including Ground Handling Agencies/Cargo Handling Agencies.

(c): The project of Biometric Access Control System, which provides for online processing of applications for airport entry permits, covers seventy-two operational airports. The Budgetary provision of Rs.65 Crore has been allocated to BCAS for FY 2016-17, which includes provisions for Biometric Access Control System.
