ONLINE AIRPORT ENTRY PASSES

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is considering to issue airport entry passes online;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the process of security clearance to ground handling and cargo handling agencies will also go online; and
- (c) whether it is also a fact that Government has sanctioned project worth Rs. 22 crore to put all the airport entry pass applications online and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b): The project relating to e-BCAS (Bureau of Civil Aviation Security) provides for online access to users including Ground Handling Agencies/Cargo Handling Agencies.
- (c): The project of Biometric Access Control System, which provides for online processing of applications for airport entry permits, covers seventy-two operational airports. The Budgetary provision of Rs.65 Crore has been allocated to BCAS for FY 2016-17, which includes provisions for Biometric Access Control System.
