# Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is planning to establish National Medical Commission (NMC) in place of Medical Council of India, if so, the details thereof;

(b) whether the State Governments have requested the Centre to increase their representation in the new NMC, if so, the details thereof; and

(c) whether Government has taken any decision on the matter and the details thereof?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI FAGGAN SINGH KULASTE)

(a): A four member committee headed by Vice Chairman NITI Aayog was constituted to examine all options for reforms in MCI and suggest way forward. The Committee has framed a draft "National Medical Commission (NMC) Bill" which provides for constitution of NMC in place of MCI.

(b) & (c): The draft NMC Bill was placed on the official website of NITI Aayog on 09.08.2016 seeking comments of Public/ Experts. Various comments including that of State Governments were received in this regard. After extensive deliberations, some suggestions have been incorporated by the Committee while submitting the final NMC Bill.
