**SKILL DEVELOPMENT CENTRES IN TELANGANA**

**1055. SHRI DHARMAPURI SRINIVAS:**

**Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether Government has decided to establish Skill Development Centres in Telangana and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether any request from the State Government has been received in this regard; and
- (c) if so, the action taken by Government on such request?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) Ministry is implementing two flagship schemes known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) and Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) on pan –India basis to cover the prospective youths. PMKVY enables large number of prospective youths for taking short term fresh training and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) through accredited and affiliated training partner/training centers. Under PMKK, Government intends to establish a Model Skill Centre in every district for imparting skill training to aspirational youths through PMKVY which includes districts of State of Telangana.

Under PMKVY 2015-16, 1,09,472 candidates have been trained in 54 Training Centres in the State of Telangana. Further, under PMKVY 2016-2020, there is a State-Engagement component which provides flexibility to state skill missions to identify additional job roles as per the local need. The total target for State of Telangana is 1,74,471 for Short Term Training including 59,611 (i.e. 14,903 per year) under the State Engagement component and additional 1,31, 358 for RPL. However, no proposal with respect to State-Engagement component under PMKVY (2016-20) has been received so far from State Skill Mission of State of Telangana.

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
