(a) to (e): The 57th National Development Council (NDC) meeting held on 27th December, 2012 was the last NDC meeting held. It considered the draft Twelfth Five Year Plan. The 12th Five Year Plan presented a comprehensive assessment of the many challenges in achieving the Plan objective of faster, more inclusive and sustainable growth.

The First Meeting of the Governing Council of NITI Aayog, as a follow up action, initiated an exercise relating to appraisal of 12th Five Year Plan. The Appraisal broadly covered physical and financial targets for the first 4 years of the Plan (2012-16) and Financial Targets (Budget Estimates) for the terminal year (2016-17) of the 12th Five Year Plan.
