125. SHRI PRABHAT JHA:

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Central Government is working on the target to provide 'pucca houses' to all the families living in 'kuchcha houses' in rural areas;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the total number of families living in 'kuchcha houses' in Madhya Pradesh at present and by when those families will be provided with 'pucca houses';
- (d) whether any scheme or proposal of Madhya Pradesh Government in this regard is under Government's consideration; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAM KRIPAL YADAV)

- (a) & (b): To achieve the objective of 'Housing for All by 2022' the rural housing scheme Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY) has been re-structured into Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) which aims to provide pucca house with basic amenities to all houseless households and households living in kutcha and dilapidated house in rural areas of the country. In initial phase one crore houses are proposed to be constructed over the period of three years from 2016-17 to 2018-19.
- (c): As per SECC data, total number of families living in zero, one or two room kutcha house (kutcha wall and kutcha roof) in the State of Madhya Pradesh are 47,45,550 Under PMAY-G, the Government aims to provide housing for all by 2022.
- (d) & (e): Request for sanction of special projects under PMAY-G have been received from Government of Madhya Pradesh in the Ministry of Rural Development and no decision on the request has been taken so for.
