- (a) & (b): Substantial grant is provided by the Government for research work in various fields of science and technology to elevate R&D status of the country. Major portion of BE 2017-18 allocation of Rs. 11,505.48 crores, of Ministry of Science and Technology is earmarked for institutions and individuals as grants for undertaking research in these institutions. In addition, grants are also provided for emerging and promising areas such as nanotechnology, advanced materials and high performance computing. New strategic areas like cyber-physical systems, smart machines also receive special consideration in the release of funds. Sophisticated and analytical instrumentation facilities, powerful computational facilities and other research infrastructure have been established in Universities and other institutions through research grants provided under various schemes.
