### **NEW TELECOM POLICY**

#### 870. DR. SANJAY SINH:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government proposes New Telecom Policy in the country;
- (b) if so, whether Government proposes relief packages to Telecom sector;
- (c) if so, the reasons behind supporting private telecom companies and the contract details during their award;
- (d) the reasons for changing policies of Government to favour the private telecom players; and
- (e) the present debt position of the telecom companies in the country?

- (a) to (d) The Department of Telecommunications envisages to formulate a new National Telecom Policy in view of rapid technological advancement in the sector. The work on formulation of National Telecom Policy-2018 has been initiated and is targeted to be finalized by March, 2018. Several Working Groups have been constituted on different themes for this purpose.
- (e) As per Report of the Inter Ministerial Group (IMG), the total debt of Telecom Industry is Rs.7.88 Lakh Crores.
