STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS(A) TO (C) OF THE RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO.303 TO BE ANSWERED ON 23.03.2018

(a) to (c) Yes, Sir. For financing infrastructure requirements of animal husbandry and fisheries sector, in the Budget 2018-19, the Government of India has announced the setting up of Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FAIDF) and an Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF) with total corpus of Rs.10,000 crore. The Expenditure Finance Committee, Ministry of Finance has considered and recommended the implementation of Fisheries Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Funds (FAIDF) Scheme with a total outlay of Rs.7522.48 crore with loan disbursement/capital investment period of five years w.e.f. 2017-18 to 2021-22, and with repayment period of 10 years. A moratorium of 2 years will be there on repayment of principal. The contribution of Government of India will be limited to Rs. 939.48 crore to meet the interest subvention cost and administrative expenses.

For setting up of Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF), no specific allocation has been made so far.
