The Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) is being implemented through State Governments who in turn are implementing it through existing district machinery. Supervision and monitoring is done by the concerned State Government and contractual staff and they are being given regular training through customized courses to enhance their capacities and also for creating awareness.
