- (a) whether regional channels of Doordarshan telecast the programmes in several Indian languages;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Doordarshan broadcasts any regional channels in Maithili language; and
- (d) if so, whether there is a proposal of commencing regional channel of Doordarshan in Maithili language?

- (a) & (b): Prasar Bharati has informed that at present, there are 16 (24x7) Regional languages satellite channels, producing and telecasting programmes in the respective Regional languages and dialects. The details of which are as under:-
