AMOUNT DUE BY PRIVATE AIRLINE COMPANIES TO GOVERNMENT

2735. SHRI VIVEK K. TANKHA

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) the number of private airlines/companies operating domestic and international flights in the country and the details thereof;
- (b) the approximate market share of these companies in terms of traffic and revenue;
- (c) the total amount owed by each of these private airlines companies to the Government agencies by way of dues as on date towards licence fee, fuel charges, taxes, airport charges and other heads; and
- (d) the steps proposed to be taken by Government to recover such pending dues?

(a): The private airline companies operating scheduled domestic and international flights as per Winter Schedule, 2017 as as follows:

Scheduled Domestic operators:

Jet Airways, Jet Lite, Indigo, Spice Jet, Go Air, Trujet, Vistara, Air Asia, Zoom Air, Air Odisha & Deccan Charter

Scheduled International operators:

Jet Airways, Indigo, Spice Jet

(b): The market share of the Scheduled Indian carriers is placed as Annexure-I.

(c) &(d) Sector wise details of outstanding taxes are not maintained. However, outstanding dues in respect of the private airlines operating domestic and international flights as on 31.12.2017 owed to Airports Authority of India is as under:
