Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government has formulated any scheme to introduce Oncology Surgery Course in the Medical Colleges situated in the State of Telangana;

(b) if so, the details thereof; and

(c) if not, reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (c): No. However, Osmania Medical College, Hyderabad was permitted 3 seats for M.Ch (Surgical Oncology) Course. It is for Medical Colleges to apply to the Central Government for starting a Course under Section 10A of Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 & Regulations framed thereunder.
