**DECREASE IN RECORDED MALARIA CASES**

**2836. SHRIMATI VIJILA SATHYANANTH:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that India has reduced its new malaria cases by one-third and even crossed the malaria mortality targets of 2020;
- (b) whether it is also a fact that with nearly three fourth of the share of the regional burden, India's success had significantly contributed to the reduction of the burden of malaria for the entire Southeast Asia region;
- (c) whether a majority of malaria cases in the country occurred in its border districts, forests and tribal areas; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER

(a): The number of malaria cases has been reduced by 28 percent in 2017 as compared to 2015 (base year of global targets) and number of deaths has been reduced by 73 percent whereas the global target of reduction in number of deaths is by 40 percent in the year 2020. Malaria situation in the country is at **Annexure**.

(b): As per the World Malaria Report 2017 of World Health Organisation (WHO), the estimated malaria cases from India is 87% in South East Asia region. Reduction in the number of Malaria cases in India does have an impact on the malaria situation in the region.

(c) & (d): Majority of the malaria cases are reported in the States of Odisha, Chattisgarh, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Meghalaya and Tripura because of the inaccessible terrain - many areas get cut –off post monsoon where malaria continues to be higher in many pockets. These 6 states contribute to 77 percent of total malaria in the country.
