CLOSURE OF HYDRO PROJECTS DUE TO ENVIRONMENTAL OBJECTIONS

2880. SHRI MOHD. ALI KHAN:

Will the Minister of **POWER** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that several hydro power projects on Alaknanda and Bhagirathi rivers were closed due to environmental objections;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether Government is taking any steps to operationalise these power units?

ANSWER

- (a) & (b): Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide its order dated 13.08.2013, directed not to grant any further Environmental and Forest Clearances to the Hydro Electric Schemes (HES) in the state of Uttarakhand until further orders. However, Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide its order dated 12.10.2015, clarified that the order dated 13.08.2013 prohibiting Environmental and Forest Clearances to HE Schemes in the State of Uttarakhand is applicable to 24 HE Schemes only. The details of such Schemes are furnished in the **Annexure**.
- (c): In compliance of the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court, Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change (MoEF&CC) constituted a fresh Expert Body headed by Dr. B. P. Das on 03.06.2015 to carry out Cumulative Impact Assessment (CIA) and Carrying Capacity Study (CCS) in the upper reaches of river Ganga and its tributaries. The Expert Body has submitted its draft final report to MoEF&CC in September, 2017.
