- (a) whether Government has any data of the unprotected monuments and sites located in the State of Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether Government has framed any specific guidelines for the preservation and restoration of these monuments and sites in the State; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a)&(b) The Government of India, under the National Mission on Monuments and Antiquities has initiated the documentation of built heritage across the country including Maharashtra. So far 4941 monuments and sites in Maharashtra have been registered in the National Inventory.
- (c)&(d) The Archaeological Survey of India has formulated a National Conservation Policy and the preservation and restoration of protected monuments and sites are carried out accordingly. The unprotected heritage of the country are also governed under the said policy, however it is not mandatory at present.
