Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a Scheme named 'Safeguarding the Intangible Cultural Heritage and Diverse Cultural Traditions of India' has been launched for activities/projects to strengthen, protect, preserve and promote the intangible cultural heritage of India; and
- (b) whether there is also a proposal to initiate activity/project for intangible cultural heritage and promotion of Mithila region of Bihar under this scheme; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

(a) Yes Sir, a Scheme named 'Safeguarding the Intangible Cultural Heritage and Diverse Cultural Traditions of India' was launched by the Ministry of Culture in November, 2013 with the objective of reinvigorating and revitalizing various institutions, groups, individuals, identified non-MoC institutions, non-government organisations, researchers and scholars so that they may engage in activities/ projects for strengthening, protecting, preserving and promoting the rich intangible cultural heritage of India. The scheme is being implemented through Sangeet Natak Akademi, an autonomous organisation under the Ministry of Culture.

(b) & (c) Yes Sir, a total of 4 proposals aimed at the promotion of intangible cultural heritage of Mithila region of Bihar have been received under the Scheme so far. The details of the proposals are attached as **Annexure**..
