MINIMUM WAGES IN STATES AND UTs

2976. SHRI DARSHAN SINGH YADAV: SHRIMATI RAJANI PATIL:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)the present status of minimum wages in each of the State and Union Territory in the country with details of when these wages were fixed by each State and UT Government;
- (b)whether Government proposes to advise the States and UTs to revise the minimum wages to give relief to workers; and
- (c)if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE(IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a): A statement (based on the available information in the Ministry) showing the category wise minimum wages in each of the State and Union Territory is annexed.

(b) to (c): Under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, both Central and State Governments are appropriate Governments to fix, review and revise the minimum wages of the workers employed in the scheduled employments under their respective jurisdictions.

Effective implementation of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948, which primarily falls in the State sphere, is diligently pursued by the Ministry through discussion, writing letters, personal interaction and visits to States and UTs. The State Governments and UT Administrations are regularly asked to fix and revise minimum wages in scheduled employments to be at least at par with national floor level minimum wage. The Central Government has lastly issued directions vide D.O. letter dated 07.06.2017 to the State Governments and UT Administrations to fix and revise minimum wages in scheduled employments at least at par with national floor level minimum wage of Rs. 176/- per day.
