#### **Criteria for Selection:**

Tender for inviting bids from filmmakers is uploaded on e-procurement portal. Bids are received against this tender in online mode only and eligible filmmakers are called for a presentation in the presence of a film selection committee. Based on the presentation and financial bid filmmaker is selected.

(c) Ministry of External Affairs invites bids through e-procurement portal and Doordarshan did not bid for any of these tenders.
