Urban Development is a State subject. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs facilitates and assists States/Union Territories (UTs), through its flagship Missions/schemes to improve urban infrastructure such as water, sewerage and sanitation and enhance the quality of life in cities and towns covered under these Missions/schemes.

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) has been launched by the Government of India on June 25, 2015 with major focus on water supply and sewerage & septage management in 500 Mission cities across the country.

Swachh Bharat Mission (Urban) scheme covers all beneficiaries of 4041 statutory towns. Under this scheme, Government provides incentives and grants for construction of Individual Household Toilets (IHHT), Community Toilets/Public Toilets (CT/PT) and Solid Waste Management (SWM) which are further to be supplemented by the State/UTs.

The State-wise details of number of households having water supply connection and sewerage connection as intimated by the States and Union Territories under AMRUT, details of toilets targeted & completed under Swachh Bharat Mission and the percentage of urban population getting the basic amenities based on the Census 2011 is given in Annexure.
