- (a) the total number of BPL families identified/covered under the Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS); and
- (b) the reasons for not covering the entire BPL families, identified under the TPDS?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD & PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION (SHRI RAMVILAS PASWAN)

(a) & (b): The Targeted Public Distribution System is now governed by provisions of the National Food Security Act, 2013 (NFSA), under which coverage of population for receiving highly subsidized foodgrains has been delinked from poverty estimates. The Act provides for coverage of upto 75% of rural and 50% of urban population, at the all India level, under two categories- households covered under Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) and priority households. There is no BPL category under NFSA.
