Funds for Berach river under NRCP

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government intends to sanction an amount of ₹ 87.49 crores for Abatement of Pollution Project for Berach (Ayad) river, Udaipur under National River Conservation Plan (NRCP);
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (DR. MAHESH SHARMA)

(a) to (c) A project proposal for "Abatement of pollution, river flow channelization and river front beautification of Berach (Ayad) river in Udaipur" costing ₹87.49 crore was received in May, 2015 from Rajasthan Urban Infrastructure Finance Development Corporation Limited (RUIFDCO), Jaipur for its consideration under National River Conservation Plan (NRCP) in May, 2015. However, the proposal was returned back to RUIFDCO as river Ayad is a part of Ganga River Basin and does not come under the purview of NRCP.
