**CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS UNDER PMGSY IN MADHYA PRADESH**

**3479. DR. SATYANARAYAN JATIYA:**

Will the Minister of **RURAL DEVELOPMENT** be pleased to state the length of the roads constructed in Madhya Pradesh during last three years till date since the implementation of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) and the system adopted for their proper maintenance and the expenditure incurred on the maintenance of these roads, so far, district-wise?

The length of the roads constructed in Madhya Pradesh during the last three years till date under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) is given below:

<b>Year</b>	<b>Length in km.</b>
<b>2014-15</b>	<b>5180.92</b>
<b>2015-16</b>	<b>4453.23</b>
<b>2016-17</b>	<b>5081.97</b>

Against a total sanctioned length of 80,388.31 Km the State has completed 68,743.25 Km till date. As per the PMGSY guidelines, all roads sanctioned under PMGSY will be covered under 5 years maintenance by contractors (Defect liability Period) and after defect liability period, State should maintain the roads. Maintenance of these roads is the responsibility of the State Government out of its own resources. District-wise expenditure on maintenance of roads in Madhya Pradesh during 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17 and 2017-18 till date is as per **Annexure**.
